The Sam and Rose Foulk Memorial Scholarship

(Applicants must reside on the Peninsula and may be public or private school students who will be attending PCHS in the 9th grade.)

The *Sam and Rose Foulk Memorial Scholarship* will be awarded to a rising 9th grade student at Peninsula Catholic High School who has demonstrated academic excellence and who needs financial assistance to attend Peninsula Catholic.

The scholarship will be funded annually with a gift of **\$6,000** payable to Peninsula Catholic High School for the four years that the recipient attends Peninsula Catholic as long as the established academic and service criteria are maintained.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROCESS AND CRITERIA

1. The applicant must have and maintain a GPA of 3.0.
2. The applicants can be either Catholic or non-Catholic and may be from a public or private school. He or she must reside on the Peninsula (Hampton, Newport News, York County) and must be entering 9th grade.
3. The applicant must complete a three page application available on the website or from the school. His/her parents must apply for financial aid through FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment (www.factstuitionaid.com).
4. The applicant must be involved in community service while in high school. Documentation will be required and shall be provided to the donors.
5. The recipient will receive the scholarship for the four years that he/she attends PCHS as long as all the established requirements of the scholarship are maintained.
6. The President, Principal, and Guidance Director of Peninsula Catholic shall select the recipient of the scholarship in the spring of 2010. Prior to the announcement of the recipient, the donor shall be notified.
7. Through the administration, the donors wish to maintain involvement with the recipient receiving grades and other pertinent information on a timely basis. The recipient and parents will sign a release form enabling the administration to forward academic information.
8. The deadline for submission of the application is April 12, 2010.
