Dear Parents/Guardians:

Greetings from Peninsula Catholic! With the second term well underway, we begin preparations for the new academic year 2010 – 2011. This is a multifaceted process which continues up to the first day of classes. It begins with the preparation of the curriculum guide and course selection. As you know, your student(s) have met or will meet with our Guidance Counselor, Mrs. Christine Miller, to discuss courses for next year. The second step is re-registration.

In order for your student(s) to be scheduled for classes, you must re-register for next year by completing the enclosed **SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011 FINANCIAL CONTRACT (green)**. Please read the **Financial Information Sheet (yellow)** very carefully before filling out the contract. Note, in particular, that the fees (per student) will be billed separately and cannot be rolled into the FACTS agreement.

Please return the **SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011 FINANCIAL CONTRACT (green) with the \$100 registration fee (per family) by MARCH 29, 2010**. Families who are on **FACTS** for tuition payments will be reenrolled by the Finance Director if there are **no bank changes** in your agreement. Please note that you can make either 10 or 12 payments. The 10 payment plan begins in September and ends in June. The 12 payment plan begins in July and ends in June. All payments for the 2010-2011 school year must be made by June 30, 2011. **Please contact the business office if you need a new FACTS agreement form. Financial Aid applications should be filed by APRIL 7. A FACTS Grant and Aid information sheet is enclosed.** You can request an application from the finance office or you can file online at www.factstuitionaid.com. Only one application is necessary for financial aid from Peninsula Catholic and aid sponsored by the Diocese (the McMahon Parater Foundation and Increased Offertory Fund). We forward the names of applicants from here to the Diocese. **The Diocese WILL NOT consider applications that are incomplete or not verified by FACTS Grant and Aid so please adhere to the deadline for filing for financial aid.**

We regret that tuition must increase, but it is our only secure income. It covers only 85% of our preliminary budget. The remainder must be made up through the Annual Appeal, donations, and other fundraising efforts.

Course requests will not be scheduled until students are formally re-registered. Enrollment in courses is critical in determining the electives and the number of sections of core courses that will be offered. Some classes have limited space and scheduling will be on a first come/first served basis. Your assistance in returning the contract promptly will greatly help us with planning and preparing for next year.

As we continue our Lenten journey, may the Lord bless you and your families with His grace and love.
